

There are currently over 2,300 return locations, including 25 redemption centers (276 RVMs), 30 BottleDrop Express sites, and 2,254 retail drop off sites (360 RVMs).</p>	<p>Estimate is from a 2012 - 2013 study commissioned by the State, as the redemption rate has not been measured and reported on annually.</p>
